## 2010 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - GUIDELINES

Scholarships are available to athletes normally resident in Tasmania who are registered with a national or state sporting organisation. Assistance is available for individual athletes as outlined below. The Tasmanian Institute of Sport 2010 individual athlete scholarship program will operate from 1 January 2010 to 31 December 2010.

### Individual Athletes

Outstanding athletes from either individual or team sports may apply for and be awarded individual scholarships. These scholarships are available in two categories, **Elite** or **Elite Development**. A scholarship with the Tasmanian Institute of Sport will be primarily determined by the following criteria:

- (a) the athlete's ranking and performances in his/her sport at junior national, senior national and/or international level;
- (b) the athlete's potential for advancement to or improvement at international level;
- (c) the number of high performance or potential high performance competitors within the sport;
- (d) the proposed annual competition and training program of the athlete.

Athletes will be requested to submit a training program for the scholarship period, indicating their competition and training requirements and a projected estimate of associated costs.

**Individual Scholarships are not offered to the following sports as they are currently supported by a TIS Sports Program: AFL Football, Basketball, Canoe (wildwater), Cricket, Cycling, Football (Soccer), Hockey, Netball, Rowing, Sailing, Swimming, Triathlon and Track and Field.**

- All basketball, cycling, football (soccer), hockey, netball, rowing and track and field athletes are assessed according to selection criteria as specified by the relevant Tasmanian National Training Centre (NTC) program.
- All AFL football, canoe (wildwater), cricket, sailing, swimming and triathlon athletes are assessed according to Elite Development Program (EDP) criteria.

Selection criteria and details of each program are available from the programs' head coaches in basketball, cycling, football (soccer), hockey, netball, rowing and track and field or the relevant state sporting organisation for AFL football, canoe (wildwater), cricket, sailing, swimming and triathlon.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE

Athletes who are offered Tasmanian Institute of Sport scholarships must agree to comply with the following terms and conditions of the scholarship which require them to:

- (a) continue their sporting careers during the scholarship year;
- (b) report as required on their athletic performance and progress;
- (c) under no circumstances use performance enhancing drugs or methods prohibited by international sporting regulations. Scholarship holders failing to comply with this condition will have their scholarship cancelled immediately;
- (d) consent to wear Institute uniforms when competing for the Institute and wear Institute insignia when officially representing their country, state or club;
- (e) adhere to their competition and training objectives as submitted to the Institute;
- (f) assist as required in promotional activities organised by the Tasmanian Institute of Sport;
- (g) give due recognition to the Tasmanian Institute of Sport and the State Government in all public and media appearances;
- (h) participate in Institute seminars, meetings and workshops when required by the Institute;
- (i) undertake appropriate sports science testing in consultation with their individual coach or Tasmanian Institute of Sport staff;
- (j) conduct themselves in a manner befitting scholarship holders of the Tasmanian Institute of Sport;
- (k) have their career, education and personal development monitored by the Institute through the Athlete Career and Education program;
- (l) reside in Tasmania for the term of the scholarship unless otherwise approved by the Tasmanian Institute of Sport Board of Management.
- (m) be working with an NCAS accredited coach who agrees to sign the TIS Coaches' Code of Conduct

The above terms and conditions do not automatically qualify an applicant, on obtaining the relative standard, to a scholarship in any category. The granting of scholarships remains the sole prerogative of the Board of Management of the Tasmanian Institute of Sport, who may at their discretion alter these terms and conditions.

The level of funding for scholarships will vary according to:

- (a) the level of interstate and international competition at which the athlete is performing;
- (b) the nature and scale of the training program;
- (c) the nature and scale of TIS support services and equipment required;
- (d) the level of other funding/support of which the athlete/squad members may be in receipt.
