In 2017 Sarah was selected in the Australian Women's Four to compete in World Cups 2 and 3 and the World Rowing Championships. Sarah and the rest of the crew did not lose a race in 2017. The crew were also crowned the 2017 Female Australian Crew of the Year at the 2017 Rower of the Year Awards.

Sarah, the current Women's Four World Champion, will be making her Olympic debut at the 2020 Olympic Games.
