Chris was born in Tasmania, moving with his family to Queensland when he was eight, where basketball was his main focus.

With majority of his playing career spent in the NBL, Chris also spent time with the Cleveland Cavaliers and Dallas Mavericks for the summer league in 2013 and 2014 respectively.

Chris led Melbourne United to the grand final in the 2015-16 season and then travelled to Italy to play for Auxilium Torino.

He made his Olympic debut at the 2016 Rio Games, where Australia finished fourth, following a loss to Spain in the bronze medal match.

Since Rio, Chris and Melbourne United won the 2017-18 NBL Grand Final and made the 2018-19 NBL grand final series. In June 2021, Chris played his 350th NBL game.

Chris will make his second Olympic appearance in Tokyo, playing with the Australian Boomers.
